## What Is TreatmentMatch.org?

TreatmentMatch.org is a centralized, strictly confidential way for physicians to select and contact patients as treatment openings become available in his or her practice.

This web-based system offers patients in need of Buprenorphine treatment the opportunity to anonymously register and, in effect, be on the waiting lists of all participating certified physicians in their geographic area.

- Email alert option as new patients register
- Potential patients are screened through a 16-question registration form
- 24/7 access to a continuously updated list of potential patients
- Potential patient is notified by email to contact you for an appointment
- Patients are required to renew their status every two weeks if not contacted
- Reduced office time spent:
  In maintaining your own waiting list
  Placing phone calls to reach potential patients
- Optional listing on public locator


